## 2008 Golf Montana's Flathead Valley

Montana's Flathead Valley is home to ten championship golf courses all within forty-five minutes drive of one another, offering a mix of mature, well-tended courses, more contemporary layouts with carpets of bent-grass greens, open links-style layouts, and tight, forest-lined fairways. Add the majestic surroundings, amazingly low prices and friendly locals, and it's golf the way it used to be.

**Whitefish/ WFG:** Montana's only 36-hole golf complex located adjacent to Whitefish Lake, affords fabulous mountain views and is the most requested destination for Montana golfers. Pine and birch trees line both the North and South Course's well-manicured fairways. **Big Mountain/ BMG:** An exquisite and challenging 18-hole layout, Northern Pines combines traditional Scottish links with natural towering pines winding along the Stillwater River. Designed by Andy North, this course rivals the top public courses in the country and features breathtaking scenery. *10 minutes from Whitefish*

**Meadow Lake/ MLG:** Nestled in its own private setting and protected by the towering peaks of the Rocky Mountains lies this beautiful 18-hole championship golf course. Meadow Lake's 330 gently rolling acres offer trees, crystal clear lakes and streams, and spectacular mountain views of Glacier National Park. **Buffalo Hill/ BHG:** This 27-hole golf course is one of the most popular golf courses in the Flathead Valley. **Village Greens/ VGG:** The Flathead Valley's finest bent grass greens and immaculate overall course condition can be found at Village Greens Golf Club. Spectacular fairway mounding, crystal clear lakes and beautiful white sand complement the Valley's fastest growing golf course. *20 minutes from Whitefish*

**Eagle Bend/ EBG:** Eagle Bend Golf Club has been long rated the #1 course in Montana and among the top 50 courses in the U.S. by Golf Digest. Eagle Bend features 27 holes of golfing including the "Nicklaus Nine." You'll enjoy beautiful lake, mountain and river views from this exceptional golf course. *45 minutes from Whitefish*

**Polson/ POL:** A valley favorite for decades, Polson Country Club features spectacular views of Flathead Lake and Mission Mountain range from every hole. The front nine was opened in 1989 and features a longer, more modern design, while the back nine was built in 1936 and is shorter, with fairways lined with majestic pines and fir trees. *75 minutes from Whitefish*

**Mission Mountains/ MMG:** This 18-hole golf course is located 14 miles south of Flathead Lake in the heart of beautiful Mission Valley. The course features lush fairways and some of Montana's largest and finest greens with a fantastic view of the Mission Mountains. *90 minutes from Whitefish*

**Glacier View/ GVG:** This 18-hole golf course is located in West Glacier, featuring breathtaking views of majestic peaks in Glacier National Park. Very relaxed and family orientated course. *45 minutes from Whitefish*
